Marion County EMS (MCEMS) is the sole EMS provider in Marion County Kentucky. Established in 1982, MCEMS provides service to a population of 20,000 that reside in the 347 square miles of the county. Based out of one station centrally located in Lebanon MCEMS operates 2 Advanced Life Support units 24/7/365, answering over 2,700 requests for service annually. The crews work under protocols established by the Kentucky Board of EMS and are able to utilize equipment such as follows; Stryker power stretchers and power truck loads, Stryker tract system stair chairs, Lifepack 15 monitors, ESO epcr on tough book laptops, Dfibtech Lifearm external CPR devices and more.



Benefits for Full-Time Employees Include

- Health Insurance - Employer pays 100% for Employee
- Dental Insurance - Employer pays 100% for Employee
- Life Insurance - \$20,000 employee policy paid 100%
- Paid Holidays - Currently paid for 10 holidays (Part time employees as well when working)
